## **BRO. MARSHALL'S MESSAGE**

#### **Fasting**

Luke 5:33 And they said to Him, "The disciples of John often fast and offer prayers, the disciples of the Pharisees also do the same, but Yours eat and drink."

We had had no water for about six weeks and every other day or so, we had to get it from the "water guys". They brought it in on a donkey cart in a large tank and pumped it into our compound. This particular day, there was a new driver and I began a gospel conversation with him. After they finished pumping water, I invited them to stay for lunch. He said that they couldn't because they were fasting. Now the Orthodox fast on Wednesdays and Fridays and this was a Tuesday. So I asked why he was fasting and he told me that it was a three day fast called the Jonah fast. I inquired as to why they fasted for three days and he said because the priest tells us to. He didn't even know the story of Jonah, so I shared the story with him and we concluded that they were either fasting three days because he was in the belly of the fish three days or because Nineveh was three days across. Either way, I told him that he should be able to eat fish during the Jonah fast. He didn't find that as amusing as I did.

Here's the point, Jesus tells us that we should fast and we see many examples of fasting in the New Testament. However, it was not a "scheduled" fast, or because someone told them to fast. Rather, it was usually because there was either an important decision that needed to be made or a problem of some kind. Bottom line, the church corporately and the people of the church are supposed to fast. Have you ever fasted? Why? For how long? What was the result?
